COMMITTEES

Fundraising: As part of this committee, Thursday 14th November will be our first fundraising event collecting for Children in Need which will take the form of a dress down day for pupils, paying £1 at Registration followed by a bake sale, duck race, guess no. of sweets in the jar, guess baby photos of committee members as well as face paints and hairsprays.
